



ASOCIACIÓN EDUCACIONAL WILLIAMSON DEL PERÚ ASSOCIATE PARENT OR ASSOCIATE GUARDIAN STATEMENT

The undersigned associate parent or associate guardian, in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of Law No. 26549, Law of Private Schools, amended by the Emergency Decree No. 002-2020 and the Regulations of the Supreme Decree No. 005-2021-MINEDU, consistent with Law No. 27665, Law of Family Economy Protection, regarding the payment of tuitions in private educational centres and programmes, which modifies the aforementioned Law No. 26549 and Ministerial Resolution No. 587-2023-MINEDU, **DECLARES:**

FIRST: TO KNOW the objectives and the axiological line of Newton College, as well as the principles, aims and objectives that are established in the Internal Regulations of the School, expressing his/her commitment to observe and respect the aforementioned axiological line, principles, goals and regulations, which means that according to the provisions of Article 14 of the Political Constitution of Peru, teaching is provided at all levels, subject to the institutional principles and the corresponding purposes of the educational institution.

SECOND: TO ACKNOWLEDGE information provided by the School with regard to the educational cost for 2024 and to make a commitment to honour the payments of the monthly fees for the Associate (equivalent to the school tuitions) up to the last day of each month, recognising that the School's operations and investment budgets are financed, basically, by the Associate's monthly fees, which also fund the payments of wages for the teaching, administrative and maintenance personnel, as well as the acquisition of goods and payment of utilities (electricity, water, phone, etc.), and that the timely and punctual payment of these fees avoids interest and penalties established by the institution, in accordance to law.

THIRD: TO KNOW that the amount of Associate's monthly fees, equivalent to the educational tuition during the year 2024, may be increased according to institutional needs, inflation and/or the increase in prices of goods and services needed to continue with the educational services.

FOURTH: TO KNOW that it is optional and voluntary that the associate parent or associate guardian takes the accident insurance policy for students which the School may offer.

FIFTH: TO BE AWARE OF the current legal regulations applicable in the event of withdrawal or transfer of his/her child or minor under custody, with respect to the proportional refund of the admission fee paid to the Association, and expressly pledges not to make any requests or claims to the School or to Asociación Educacional Williamson del Perú that are not considered under the current legal norms.



SIXTH: TO KNOW that Asociación Educacional Williamson del Perú or the School have the power to retain transcripts from unpaid periods and/or to not ratify the student's enrolment for the following year due to lack of punctuality in the payment of the monthly fees, equivalent to the educational tuition of the educational service provided in the 2024 school year.

SEVENTH: TO ACCEPT that failure to comply with monthly payments, equivalent to the educational tuition, will result in monthly penalty interest, as established by the Central Reserve Bank of Peru, for operations between people unconnected to the financial system.

EIGHTH: TO KNOW that parents are the main responsible party for the education of children. He/she assumes the commitment to participate in the educational process provided by the School to their child(ren), by attending all academic, formative and recreational activities to which the Associate is summoned, to informative talks, conferences or meetings coordinated by the School and especially in compliance with the obligations assumed in cases of family therapy and external accompaniment of their child(ren) when required by the institution. Additionally, the Associate undertakes the commitment to share the reports of external specialists with our Student Engagement Department to work as a team for the well-being of the student.

NINTH: TO SPECIFY that the person in charge of paying the monthly fees, equivalent to the educational tuition, and all other expenses previously detailed is **SURNAMES AND GIVEN NAMES OF THE ASSOCIATE**.

TENTH: TO KNOW AND ACCEPT that the account statements, collection notices and invitations to meetings with the Administration to discuss economic matters will be sent to the emails of both parents.

ELEVENTH: TO KNOW that the Intranet is the main mean of communication between Newton College and the parents, who may log in with their family username and password and who commit to review and read all information daily uploaded by the institution.

TWELFTH: TO KNOW AND ACCEPT that, upon signing this Statement, the Associate has accessed the family Intranet and has seen, read and downloaded from it all documents to be known by parents: Operating License, Directorial Resolutions of Authorisation, Enrolment Circular, Cost of tuitions and admission fee, Amount and payment date of the admission fee, documents required from new students, Institutional Curricular Plan, school calendar, number of students per class, school timetable, number of vacancies, Institutional Educational Project, School Coexistence Policy, Guidelines to respond in cases of school violence (for parents), Guidelines to respond in cases of school violence (for students), Internal Regulations, Communication Plan in case of emergency, Professional Status of the Director, Senior Staff and teachers, Information of the promoter and the Director, Ethical Guide for Parents, Data Protection Policy, ARCO Rights, Authorisation and consent for taking and using pictures, and publishing pictures and videos, Ethics Committee Regulations, By-laws of Asociación Educacional Williamson del Perú, By-laws of the Parents and Teachers Association of Newton College.

THIRTEENTH: TO KNOW that, according to current legal provisions, within the framework of curricular diversification and the free availability of one third of the curricular hours to which the educational institution is entitled, during the school year there may be changes in the distribution of hours, in order to optimise the educational service, ensuring that it meets the minimum hours set in each educational level.



FOURTEENTH: TO COMMIT not to involve the educational institution in any judicial or extrajudicial process on the matter of custody and/or visitation regime of your child(ren).

FIFTEENTH: TO ACKNOWLEDGE that the provisions of this Associate Parent or Associate Guardian Statement are of mandatory compliance by both the School and the Associate, for it constitutes an agreement between the parties, which they sign in acceptance.
