3. NEWTON COLLEGE'S ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Newton College offers a comprehensive educational programme grounded in a Peruvian-British culture, supported by the prestigious International Baccalaureate programmes: Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and Diploma Programme (DP).

Academic excellence is the cornerstone of our educational approach. We focus on creating a nurturing environment that encourages every student to reach their full potential by combining academic rigour with meaningful learning experiences.

Our educational programme is designed with English as the primary language of instruction, enabling students to develop it as a second language at an advanced level. This immersion ensures that our students acquire the skills and fluency needed to excel in English across professional, academic, and personal contexts, solidifying their global preparedness.

Additionally, we boast exceptional infrastructure that reinforces our commitment to academic excellence. Our campus includes modern science labs, audiovisual and recording rooms, a swimming pool, and extensive sports fields, providing optimal spaces for learning, innovation, and the holistic development of our students. Furthermore, the campus connects students with nature through outdoor areas that offer opportunities to breathe, relax, and enjoy enhanced well-being and quality of life, fostering a vital balance between academic and personal growth.



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Our faculty is composed of both Peruvian and international teachers who guide our students from Early Years to Upper School. This cultural and professional diversity promotes a genuine international mindset and allows us to incorporate the best global educational practices. Notably, all tutors from Pre-Kinder to 5th Grade are international educators, and in Upper School, 40% of the teaching staff also come from abroad.

We provide our students with the necessary educational resources for their learning, including academic textbooks, reading materials, notebooks, and digital tools. In Lower School, students are equipped with Chromebook devices for academic activities within the school, enhancing their digital learning experience.

Our programmes are designed to offer authentic and meaningful experiences that foster inquiry, critical and creative thinking, self-management, communication across various formats, and the development of digital literacy. Additionally, we enrich their education with co-curricular activities such as study visits, expert conferences, and sports, artistic, and cultural events in collaboration with other educational institutions.

This educational offering is complemented by a diverse range of extracurricular activities, including sports, dance, theatre, music, Model United Nations (MUN), and more. These activities, available at convenient times, allow our students to explore their interests, discover their passions, and develop essential life skills.

4. EDUCATIONAL SERVICE FEES FOR 2025

The cost of the educational service for the 2025 academic year, as communicated in our circulars dated October 29th and November 7th, is detailed below:

* The annual fee is divided into 11 equal instalments, where the first instalment corresponds to the tuition fee.

*For the 2025 academic year, from February to December, the Asociación Educacional Williamson del Perú has established an 8.6% increase in the monthly payment applicable from Kindergarten to Form VI. In Nursery and Pre-Kinder, the increase is adjusted separately.

Please make the monthly payments through the collection services of BCP, BBVA Continental, Interbank, or Scotiabank, in U.S. dollars and/or in soles (current month). For payments in soles, the exchange rate is set by the school and will be adjusted according to market exchange rate fluctuations.

Families who wish to voluntarily apply for the monthly discount of US\$40.00 must make the payment within the first 10 days of each month.



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6. 2025 ENROLMENT PROCESS

Starting on December 13th, log in to <https://intranet.newton.edu.pe/intranet/> using your family username and password. Access the "*Matrícula 2025*" link and follow the provided steps.

Step 1: Read and review the content of the document titled "Private Agreement". Upon acceptance, you will receive a confirmation email from the address matricula@newton.edu.pe

Step 2: Enrolment reservation

Please review and update the required information:

- Data Protection (1 of 6)
- Data Update Form (2 of 6) – **It is important to update phone numbers and address.**
- Details on the amount, number, and timing of payment for the 2025 educational costs (3 of 6)
- Medical Form (4 of 6)
- Authorisation and Consent Form for the recording, use, and publication of photos, videos, audios, and academic work of students (5 of 6)
- Authorisation Form for Evacuation in Case of Earthquake or Other Emergency (6 of 6)

Step 3: Payments

The payment collection system will be available at banks **starting January 7th, 2025, for those who have completed steps 1 and 2.**

If steps 1 and 2 are completed after January 7th, 2025, payment can be made through the banking system 24 hours after registration.

If the enrolment process (step 3) is not completed by February 17th, 2025, the school reserves the right to reassign the vacancy.
