



DOCUMENTATION FOR NEW STUDENT ENROLMENT

The applicant's folder indicates which documents must be submitted to proceed with the admission process. These include:

From the applicant:

- Birth certificate
- Identification document: National ID (DNI), Alien Registration Card (C.E.) or Passport
- Certificate of no outstanding debts from the previous nursery or school

From the parents:

- Identification document: National ID (DNI) or Alien Registration Card (C.E.) for both parents
- Application form
- Family income certification form

For applicants from a Peruvian school:

From 2nd grade primary to 5th grade secondary

- Original and copy of report cards for the last two years of study
- Official Study Certificates (SIAGIE) prior to the grade they are applying for
- Single Enrollment Form (SIAGIE)
- Enrollment certificate (SIAGIE)

For applicants from a school abroad:

From 2nd grade primary to 5th grade secondary

- Certificate of studies from the country of origin, duly legalized by the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and apostilled at the Peruvian Consulate in the country of origin.
